The Perigord Noir is the most visited region of the Dordogne, and includes many of the sights that you will already have heard of.

The southern part of Perigord Noir follows the Dordogne valley as it flows from west to east, while the northern part follows the valley of the River Vézère, European centre of prehistoric sites.
